Prof. Sujatha Ramdorai works on algebraic number theory, especially on Iwasawa theory. She is the first Indian to win the prestigious ICTP Ramanujan Prize, in 2006. She was also awarded the Shanti Swarup Bhatnagar Award in 2004. She is also the recipient of the 2020 Krieger-Nelson Prize for her exceptional contributions to mathematics research. Prior to joining the University of British Columbia, she was a member of the Tata Institute of Fundamental Research.
