

Instructions for Downloading the Hall Ticket / Admit Card

1. Candidates must visit the Recruitment Portal and log in using the credentials created during the application process for Advertisement No. 24/2025 <https://iisertirupatint.samarth.edu.in/index.php/site/login>
2. Enter the registered Email ID and Password in the respective fields and carefully enter the Captcha as displayed on the screen in the designated field.
3. Click the “Login” button. Upon successful login, if a secondary confirmation window appears, click on “Resubmit” in the pop-up window to proceed further and to successfully redirect to the candidate dashboard.
4. Upon successful authentication and after logging in, the candidate dashboard will display all applications submitted by the candidate, along with the details of the post applied for and the corresponding advertisement number.
5. To download the Hall Ticket / Admit Card, click on the “Written Examination” button corresponding to the post for which the application has been submitted.
6. The Hall Ticket / Admit Card shall be made available for download only one week prior to the scheduled date of examination of the post applied for.
7. Candidates are advised to download the Hall Ticket and meticulously review all information printed on the Hall Ticket immediately upon download. In the event of any difficulty in downloading the Hall Ticket or any discrepancy noticed in the details displayed, candidates shall promptly report the matter by email to srikanthvarma@iisertirupati.ac.in. Requests received after the examination date will not be entertained.
8. Candidates must read the Important Instructions to Candidates issued in connection with Advertisement No. 24/2025 and available on the Institute website. Compliance with all instructions contained therein is mandatory.
9. The Institute will not be responsible for any inability to download the Hall Ticket arising due to incorrect login credentials, failure to access the portal within the stipulated time, network/connectivity issues at the candidate’s end, or any other circumstances beyond the control of the Institute.
10. The candidature of the applicant is purely provisional. Mere issuance or download of the Hall Ticket and/or appearance in the examination shall not imply fulfillment of eligibility conditions and shall not confer any right for appointment or further stages of the recruitment process. The candidature shall remain subject to verification of all eligibility conditions and supporting documents as prescribed in Advertisement No. 24/2025. Candidates bear sole responsibility for ensuring they meet all eligibility criteria as per the Advertisement.
11. Candidates must bring a clearly legible printed copy of the Hall Ticket along with one original Government-issued photo ID proof (e.g., Aadhaar with QR code/e-Aadhaar, Driving License, Passport, or PAN Card). Photocopies, mobile images, or other IDs will not be accepted.
12. By downloading the Hall Ticket and appearing for the exam, the candidates acknowledge acceptance of all terms, conditions, and instructions issued by the Institute pertaining to the recruitment process.
